15. Kamikochi (上高地)

This place is not accessible during winter months(April 27 - Nov 15) due to snow. You will need to file a mountain climbing notification at Yokoo Sanso. Then equip yourself with proper climbing gear. Bring warm clothes, as the weather is often cold near the summit. The view at the top of the mountain is worth the climb.



If you stay overnight in Kamikochi, consider traveling to Hida Takayama, otherwise known as Little Kyoto. See #16 for more information about this ancient town.




There are 3 campsites in Kamikochi. Those are popular campgrounds where you can fully enjoy nature.

The Kappa Bridge of Kamikochi

The Kappa Bridge of Kamikochi is the most scenic spot for tourists to take photos. This picture shows the Dakezawa, Oku Hotaka Dake and a Japanese Hotel called Gosenjaku Ryokan (5,000 scale Hotel) at the left side of the bridge. Excellent apple pie from this hotel is recommended.



Kamonjigoya is located at the entrance of Myojin Pond. It used to be a mountain lodge where climbers could stay. Now it is crowded with people who come to eat the famous grilled rockfish.



Beyond Kamonjigoya is Myojin Pond, where the Okumiya of Hotaka Shrine is located. The calm water surface will give you peace of mind.

For day trips, the late bus at 1:30 pm departs here at 2:30 pm for Kamikochi Bus Terminal. prize. It is an hour's journey to Kamikochi BT.

BT has a souvenir shop and a post office, where you can buy postcards and send them to friends.
